Case Summary: Jennifer McCabe

Summary

McCabe represented a consumer in his lease of a residential property. Approximately a year after entering into a lease, the consumer discovered that his signature on the lease had been forged. Despite never having even met the consumer, McCabe indicated she witnessed the consumer sign the lease.

On review of an Agreed Statement of Facts, the Discipline Committee found that McCabe breached three (3) sections of the [Code of Ethics](#): 3, 5, and 39 and ordered him to pay a fine of \$12,500.00. McCabe was also ordered to complete the Ethics and Business Practice Course provided by the Real Estate Institute of Canada.
