Case Summary: Irina Gordon

Forum	Licence Appeal Tribunal
Decision	Registration as a salesperson revoked
Date of Decision	November 19, 2019

Summary

On October 18, 2019 the Registrar issued an Immediate Suspension Order and a Notice of Proposal to revoke the registration of Irina Gordon. The Notice of Proposal alleged that just prior to becoming registered as a salesperson, Ms. Gordon had been convicted of four counts under s. 380(1)(a) of the *Criminal Code* for providing false documents to secure loans. The Registrar alleged that, on her application for registration, Gordon falsely stated that she had never been convicted of an offence under any law. It was further alleged that, over the course of her registration, Gordon was employed by three brokerages to whom she did not disclose her prior convictions as is required.

Ms. Gordon did not appeal the Immediate Suspension Order or the Notice of Proposal. On November 19, 2019, the Registrar carried out the proposal and Gordon's registration as a salesperson was revoked.
