



Case Summary

Respondent's Name:	Allan Douglas Shephard
Forum:	Licence Appeal Tribunal (LAT or "the Tribunal")
Decision:	Application for reinstatement of registration as salesperson refused
Date of Decision:	March 10, 2020

Summary

Shephard was previously registered as a salesperson until his registration was revoked in 2014. A previous application for reinstatement was refused in 2018.

In 2019, Shephard applied again for reinstatement of his registration as a salesperson. The Registrar issued a Notice of Proposal to refuse registration on October 20, 2019. Shephard appealed the proposal and a hearing in the matter took place before the Licence Appeal Tribunal.

The Tribunal found that Shephard did not satisfy the criteria established under the Act to be eligible to reapply for registration.

In particular, the Tribunal found that Shephard had not provided new or other evidence, or shown a material change in circumstances since he was last refused registration. This conclusion was based on the fact that Shephard's employment and income situation had actually become worse since his registration was previously refused in 2018.

As a result of this finding, the Tribunal directed the Registrar to carry out the proposal to refuse the registration of Shephard.
