The Registrar must provide information about convictions under REBBA 2002, and other Acts, that result from information provided by RECO.

NOTE: Individuals and businesses found in contravention of the Real Estate and Business Brokers Act 2002, are subject to a victim fine surcharge, in addition to the specified fine, pursuant to section 60.1 of the *Provincial Offences Act*. Detail: On March 31, 2017, Victor Fishman, the former broker of record of Homelife Victory Realty Inc., pled guilty of four counts of failing to ensure that the brokerage complied with the Act. Victor Fishman was ordered to pay a fine of \$30,000, placed on probation for a period of 2 years, complete 100 hours of community service, and ordered to pay restitution in the amount \$64,156.14.
